STATEMENT OF FAITH

- 1A. We believe in the Word of God
 - 1B. We believe that every word in the Bible was inspired by God (2 Tim 3:16).
 - 2B. We believe that the entire Bible is without error in its original manuscripts (2 Pet 1:21).
 - 3B. We believe that the Word of God was designed for our practical instruction (Rom 15:4).
- 2A. We believe in God
 - 1B. We believe in the Godhead, namely, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, coexisting eternally (Mat 28: 19-20; Ps 90:2).
 - 2B. We believe that the members of the Trinity are equal in nature, attributes and perfection (1 Pet 1:2; Joh 10:30; 1 Cor 2:10).
 - 3B. We believe God created the whole universe out of nothing (Gen 1:1).
- 3A. We believe in the existence of angels, fallen and unfallen
 - 1B. We believe Satan is the original sinner who is counterfeiting and opposing the work of God (1 Pet 5:8; 2 Cor 11:13-15).
 - 2B. We believe Satan tempts, accuses, afflicts, and oppresses the believer but does not possess or have ultimate control over him (Eph 6:10-12; 1 Cor 10:13).
- 4A. We believe man was created
 - 1B. We believe man was created by God and not evolved (Gen 1:27).
 - 2B. We believe man was made in the likeness of God but as a consequence of his sin he became spiritually dead (Ps 51:5; Rom 5:12; Eph 2:13).

- 5A. We believe in the incarnation of Jesus Christ
 - 1B. We believe Jesus Christ is the son of God born of the virgin Mary conceived by the Holy Spirit (Luke 1:30-35).
 - 2B. We believe Jesus Christ received a human body and a sinless nature at birth (Phili 2:5-8; Heb 4:15).
- 6A. We believe in salvation only through Jesus Christ
 - 1B. We believe man is incapable of attaining salvation through his own efforts as in good works, water baptism or other religious practices (Eph 2:8-9).
 - 2B. We believe that salvation has been solely accomplished through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ (Rom 10:9; 1 Cor 15:34).
 - 3B. We believe that the new birth of a believer comes only through faith in Christ and that repentance is a vital part of believing, and not a separate condition for salvation (Jon 1: 12; Rom 3:22-26).
 - 4B. We believe each person who genuinely trusts in Jesus Christ as His Savior from sin is eternally saved (Jon 3:16; Acts 16:31).
- 7A. We believe in the Holy Spirit
 - 1B. We believe that the ministries of the Holy Spirit include restraining evil (2 The 2:6-7), convicting sin (Jon 16:8-11), regenerating (Tit 3:5), baptizing (1 Cor 12:13), indwelling (1 Cor 6:19), sealing (Eph 4:30), guiding (Rom 8:14), illuminating (Jon 16:12-15), and filling (Eph 5:18) those who yield to Him.
 - 2B. We believe the gifts, that is the continuous manifestation of God given abilities exercised in the church, of speaking in tongues and miraculous healings were limited to the period of the apostles and is not normative for today (1 Cor 13:8).
 - 3B. We believe that divine, enabling gifts for service are bestowed by the Spirit upon all believers (1 Cor 12:4-12; Eph 4:11-13).
- 8A. We believe in the church, the body of believers
 - 1B. We believe that all who are united to the risen Lord Jesus Christ are members of the church which is the body and bride of Christ (1 Cor 12:12-27; Eph 1:20-23).
 - 2B. We believe the church is called to live a righteous and holy lifestyle according to the power of the indwelling Spirit (Gal 5:16-23; 1 Pet 1:14-16).
- 9A. We believe in two ordinances for the church, water baptism and the Lord's Supper
 - 1B. We believe that water baptism is a public testimony of one's faith in Jesus Christ (Act 10:47-48; 16:32-33; 18:7-8), is out of obedience to Christ's command (Mat 28:19-20) and is not necessary for salvation (Act 16:24).
 - 2B. We believe that the Lord's Supper is a reminder of Jesus' death (Luke 22:19-20).
- 10A. We believe in the eternal state
 - 1B. We believe that when Christians experience physical death, their souls pass immediately into His presence and there remain in conscious bliss until their souls are reunited with their resurrected glorified bodies when Christ comes for His own at the rapture, whereupon they shall be associated with Him forever in glory (Phili 1:23; 1 The 4: 16).
 - 2B. We believe that when unbelievers experience physical death, their souls are conscious of condemnation and in misery until the final judgment of the great white throne at the end of the millennium, when their soul and body are reunited and cast into the lake of fire, not to be destroyed, but to be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of His power (Luke 16: 19-31; 2 The 1:7-9; Rev 20:11-15).
- 11A. We believe that sexuality and the divinely prescribed boundaries for the expression thereof is covered clearly in the Holy Scriptures, which limit sexual expression to the marital relationship of one man with one woman. Homosexual acts, adultery, bestiality, and all forms of fornication are categorically condemned in the Bible (Exodus 20:14; Leviticus 20:10-21; Deuteronomy 5:18; Proverbs 5:3-5, 8-13, 7:21-27; Matthew 5:27, 19:18; Luke 18:20; Romans 1:26-32, 13:9; 1 Corinthians 6:18, 10:8; Galatians 5:19; 1 Thessalonians 4:3; James 2:11; Jude 7). Furthermore, we believe that sexuality is assigned by God by or before birth, and the Bible does not permit an individual from altering their sexual identity physically or otherwise (Genesis 1:26-28; Deuteronomy 23:1; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11).
